NCNMU Announces Over \$300,000 in Scholarships to Support Future Naprapathic Professionals

Chicago, IL – NCNM University is proud to announce the launch of a new fundraising campaign aimed at raising over \$300,000 in scholarships to support future professionals in the field of naprapathic sciences. This initiative seeks to provide significant financial support to students pursuing careers in healthcare, particularly in the specialized field of naprapathy.

Details of the NCNMU Annual Scholarship Program – “NapaCare Network Scholarships”

The scholarship program is designed to cover a portion of tuition fees for various naprapathic science programs at NCNM University. The breakdown of the scholarships is as follows:

This scholarship program aims to provide substantial financial support to students enrolled in the Pre-Naprapathy, Naprapathic Assistant, and Doctor of Naprapathy programs. Each scholarship covers a significant portion of the tuition fees, making these programs more accessible to a diverse group of students.

Naprapathy Pioneers Award Scholarship Program

The Naprapathy Pioneers scholarship program is designed to cover a substantial portion of tuition fees for various naprapathic science programs at NCNM University. This is a location-based scholarship program. The breakdown of the scholarships is as follows:

Licensed Naprapaths	6	\$49,325

The Naprapathy Pioneer Awards is a one-time initiative that will provide 16 students with a 50% tuition credit. These location-based scholarships require a 3-year commitment to work in NCNMU Health Clinics in Chicago, IL. This significant financial support underscores NCNM University's commitment to developing a skilled workforce in the field of naprapathy. In each of these new locations, one NCNMU Health Clinic will be established at a time, with 10 awards granted per clinic—comprising 4 Doctor of Naprapathy (DN) awards and 6 Naprapathic Assistant Awards. As more locations are established, additional awards will become available, facilitating expansion into new areas across the United States. This initiative underscores NCNM University's dedication to cultivating a skilled workforce in the field of naprapathy.

Repayment Obligation Clause

Recipients of the **Naprapathy Pioneer Award** are required to adhere to specific terms. They must complete their enrolled program in naprapathic sciences at NCNM University and fulfill a 3-year work commitment at NCNMU Health Clinics in Chicago, IL. Should a recipient fail to complete their studies or the work commitment, they are obligated to repay the full amount of the scholarship funds received. Acceptance of the Naprapathy Pioneer Award signifies agreement to these terms and conditions.

Scholarship Categories and Specifics

NCNM University offers five main scholarship categories, each named after notable individuals who have significantly contributed to the field and the institution:

 - **Target:** Doctor of Naprapathy Program applicants

 - **Target:** Doctor of Naprapathy and Naprapathic Assistant students
 - **Focus:** Providing financial assistance to students facing financial hardship.

- 3. Theodore Rapacz, DN Award: NapraMerit Award**
 - **Focus:** Honors Dr. Theodore Rapacz's contributions to Naprapathy and NCNM University. Recognizes academic excellence, leadership, and innovation.

- 4. Charles Greer, DN Award: Diversity Empowerment Scholarship: Fostering Inclusivity in Naprapathic Medicine**

 - **Focus:** Promotes diversity and inclusivity in naprapathic medicine. Honors Dr. Charles E. Greer's perseverance and achievements as a minority student.

- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Demonstrated financial need (FAFSA)
- Passion for Naprapathic Science (personal statement)
- Leadership and extracurricular involvement
- Commitment to diversity and inclusion
- Clear articulation of professional goals
- Two letters of recommendation
- Current NCNM University application
- Active Student Membership with the American Naprapathic Association
- Adherence to NCNM University Code of Ethics
